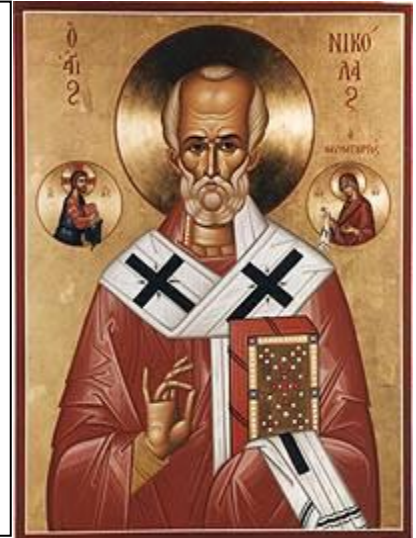
**The Nativity Fast and Sacrament of Confession
