Troparion (Resurrection)

When the women disciples of the Lord learned from the angel the joyous message of Your Resurrection, they cast away the ancestral curse and elatedly told the apostles: “Death is overthrown! Christ God is risen, granting the world great mercy!”

Troparion (Sts. Cosmas and Damian)

Having received the grace of healing, you grant healing to those in need. Glorious wonder workers and healers, Cosmas and Damian, visit us and put down the insolence of our enemies, and bring healing to the world through your miracles.

Kontakion (St. Luke)

Let us praise the godly Luke: he is the true preacher of piety, the orator of ineffable mysteries and the star of the Church; for the Word, Who alone knows the hearts of men, chose him, together with wise Paul, to be a teacher of the gentiles!

The Holy Wonderworkers Cosmas and Damian were natives of Asia Minor. Their pagan father died while they were small children. Their mother, St. Theodota, raised them in Christian piety through her own example, and by reading them holy books. They grew up to be virtuous men, were trained as physicians, and received from the Holy Spirit the gift of healing illnesses of body and soul by the power of prayer. They even treated animals. With fervent love for both God and neighbor, they never took payment for their services. Many miracles were worked after the deaths of the holy brothers.
