(Resurrection) When the women Disciples of the Lord learned from the Troparion Angel the joyous message of thy Resurrection, they cast away the ancestral curse and elatedly told the Apostles: "Death is overthrown! Christ God is risen, granting the world great mercy!"

Troparion (Sunday of Orthodoxy) We venerate Thy most pure image, O Good One, and ask forgiveness of our transgressions, O Christ our God. Of Thy good will Thou was pleased to ascend the Cross in the flesh and deliver Thy creatures from bondage to the enemy. Therefore with thankfulness we cry aloud to Thee: Thou has filled all with joy, O our Savior, for Thou didst come to save the world.

(Findings of the Head of St. John the Forerunner) The head of the Troparion Forerunner rose from the earth as a star, brilliant with rays of healing and immortality. It gathers the choirs of angels in heaven, and assembles the human race on earth

(Findings of the Head of St. John the Forerunner) O Prophet of God and Kontakion Forerunner of Grace, your head has blossomed from the earth as a sacred rose. We are ever being healed, for as of old, You preach repentance to the world.

Kontakion (Sunday of Orthodoxy) No one could describe the Word of the Father; but when He took flesh from you O Theotokos, He accepted to be described, and restored the fallen image to its former state by uniting it to divine beauty. We confess and proclaim our salvation in world and images.
